

Field Q Credits

- Every TKU student is required to complete a total of 8 credits in the Foreign Language field (referred to as Field Q) under the General Education Curriculum. The courses offered under Field Q are as follows:

English I / English II	Spanish I / Spanish II	French I / French II
German I / German II	Japanese I / Japanese II	Russian I / Russian II

- Field Q (8 Credits) = English I (4 Credits) + English II (4 Credits)**

- English II may be substituted with Spanish I/II, French I/II, German I/II, Japanese I/II, or Russian I/II (4 credits each).
- For students in English-taught programs, English II may be substituted with any of the language courses listed above, provided the course is taught in English.

2. Application Information

- (1) Certificate Validity Period: No expiration limit.
- (2) Application Period: During the first two weeks of the semester (September 14 to 29, 2026).

3. Application Steps

- (1) Online Application: Submit your application online at <https://tku.schroll.edu.tw/langcredit/>. For international students, overseas Chinese students, and students from a family in the diplomatic service, please select “International Students/Others” under the “Proof of Eligibility” category in the application system.
- (2) Verification: Bring your original certificate to the Department of English (FL207) for verification.
- (3) Course Drop: Drop the waived English course(s) online during the add/drop period.
- (4) Credit Makeup: Take elective courses to make up for the required graduation credits (no credits are awarded for waived courses).

4. Grades and Credits

- (1) Transcript Record: The waived course(s) will be marked as "Waived" on the official transcript.
- (2) Credits: No credits will be granted for waived courses.
- (3) Graduation Requirement: Students must take other elective courses to fulfill the total credit requirement for graduation.
